

Mission Statement

Generation SC is a student-led organization sponsored by Renewed Moms Ministry with a three-fold mission statement:

- **Love ... John 13:35 ...** by this all men will know you are My disciples, if you have love for one another
- **Learn ... 2 Timothy 2:15 ...** study to show yourself approved, a workman who correctly handles the Word of Truth
- **Lead ... 1 Timothy 4:12 ...** do not let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith, and in purity

The name **GENERATION SC** comes from Psalm 24:6 – *this is the generation of those who seek Him, even the God of Jacob.*

Member meetings

WHEN: Gen SC meetings are held from 3:00-4:00 pm on first Thursday of each month unless otherwise noted on the LF calendar: (www.renewedmomsministry.org)

MEMBER EXPECTATIONS: Members are expected to attend monthly meetings as the health of the whole depends on each individual. (1 Corinthians 12) In the event of an emergency or unforeseen circumstance, students should have a parent send explanation to the sponsor and the president stating why they cannot attend a regularly scheduled monthly meeting.

CONDUCT: Meetings are conducted in an orderly fashion and led by student officers. One must be recognized by the president to speak. Members must respect other's opinions and listen attentively.

Member Service

Students will be encouraged to develop our Lord's attitude, the One who didn't come to be served but to serve – anyone among us who desires to be great must become a servant as He taught His disciples.

Vice President will coordinate service projects for the group with the assistance of a service committee.

Students must present signed parental explanation for excused absence of service projects to the sponsor.

Member Socials

Students are encouraged to suggest activities they enjoy doing with their peers to social coordinator for planning.

Parents are encouraged to offer assistance and open their homes or places of business for students to hang out. The Social Coordinator will plan monthly socials, maintaining a good balance of free and paid events.

Officer Requirements

Must have served well in GEN SC for one year as a member, be nominated by fellow students, and finally selected by the sponsor

Must memorize all four GEN SC verses and be able to quote them without hesitation throughout the year

Must write an essay on their position – giving a Biblical and a modern day example of someone who performed a similar job – these examples may be someone who did the job well or did not do it well. The officer nominee must give reasons why they would like to be like the persons they chose as examples OR how they would like to avoid the mistakes of the examples they chose. Grammar or construction is not graded, but thoughtful content is mandatory.

Must attend monthly officer meetings as well as monthly membership meetings (two meetings per month)

Must communicate effectively with other officers and turn in their section of the monthly newsletter the day following each officer meeting

Must be submissive to authority, willing to serve without complaining, be a follower of Jesus, and have a teachable spirit

Must communicate effectively and thoroughly with the sponsor and LOGOS FIRST on all matters pertaining to GEN SC

Must assist the newsletter/historian by taking pictures throughout the year and sending them through the proper media

Officer Positions

President:

- Must be a proven leader, having served in another officer position prior to serving as president
- Must oversee other officers with sponsor supervision ensuring all positions are performing their jobs, assisting where needed
- Must serve as spokesperson for the group and Unknown Child events
- Must set agenda of member meetings with the VP
- Must keep records of GEN SC members
- Must contact any member who is absent from a regular meeting or scheduled service project
- Must lead member meetings and assist sponsor in leading officer meetings
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members

Vice President:

- Must take roll at member meetings
- Must set agenda of member meetings with the president
- Must coordinate annual festival with president and assigns members areas of service for the festival
- Must work with president in contacting local businesses for donations to GEN SC festival or other related events for the Unknown Child Foundation
- Must keep back up copy of GEN SC records for president
- Must keep order at member and officer meetings
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members

Chaplain:

- Must open and close every meeting in prayer
- Must prepare a sponsor-approved devotional for monthly member meetings
- Must prepare a monthly devotional on the GEN SC verses (Psalm 24:6 in September; John 13:35 in October; 2 Timothy 2:15 in November and five lessons on 1 Timothy 4:12 ...*speech* in December, *life* in January, *love* in February, *faith* in March, *purity* in April or at the lock-in) for a total of 8 devotionals each year
- Must send cards or encouragement to any GEN SC member who is sick, hospitalized or has a serious family concern
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members

Service Coordinator:

- Must oversee at least two service projects (one per semester) and assign each GEN SC member specific responsibilities at each service project
- Must assist President and VP in fund raising efforts for the Unknown Child Foundation
- Must supervise festival or any event voted on by the members with the president and VP
- Must encourage members in individual acts of service in their community and home
- Must work with the chaplain in serving for GEN SC members with sickness, hospitalization or serious family concerns
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members

Secretary:

- Must take detailed minutes at officer meetings AND member meetings
- Must send officer meeting minutes to officers and sponsor by email the day after their meeting
- Must send member meeting minutes to the sponsor the day after the member meeting for approval and placement in the newsletter for member approval the following month
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members

Newsletter Historian:

- Must have computer skills and be detail oriented
- Must retrieve officer sections of the newsletter **in timely fashion**, ensuring all spelling and grammar are accurate
- Must send newsletter to sponsor each month for final approval prior to publishing
- Must maintain the GEN SC blog with current information
- Must publish the end of the year memory book for all of GEN SC
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members

Social Coordinator:

- Must plan a monthly social for all of GEN SC – must have sponsor approval prior to sending information to group
- Must be responsible for getting member suggestions at the beginning of the year
- Must contact venues or parents to set up events
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members

Praise Band Leader:

- Must lead all practices for the praise band
- Must prayerfully audition prospects for the praise band
- Must coordinate practice schedule with the sponsor outside the time frame of any regularly scheduled officer or member meetings
- Must work with president to select dates for praise band to lead in worship for member meetings
- Must be willing to lead worship at other GEN SC or RM events if called upon
- Must pray regularly for all GEN SC members as well as praise band members
